Course level - Intermediate 1 and 2

### **Graphical Communications**

This course involves presentation skills, drawing skills and illustration skills  
Course level - Intermediate 1 and 2

### **Product Design**

This course involves learning about design, designing artefacts and making models of them

Course level - Intermediate 2 and Higher
